

The Codes of Practice are nationally developed guidelines that serve as an understanding of animal care. They outline requirements and recommended practices around animal environment, feed and water, animal health, herd management, handling, transportation, and on-farm euthanasia. They also promote sound management and welfare practices for housing, care, transportation and other animal husbandry practices.

In 2017, the Canadian Bison Association and the National Farm Animal Care Council (NFACC) released The Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Bison. It was developed with respect for and an understanding of the wild nature of bison, and reflects available scientific research. Updates to the bison code included input from representatives of all affected stakeholders.
